PER CAPITA EXONERATION GUIDELINES**

Resident taxpayers may be exonerated from payment of the Per Capita (Act 511 and Section 679) taxes levied by the School District provided they meet certain criteria.

1. Exoneration forms must be filed each year and will be considered on a yearly basis only under the provision that reasons for requesting exoneration are proven.
2. It is the responsibility of the taxpayer to obtain and submit the request for exoneration no later than August 1 of the taxing year.
3. Forms are available from the tax collector and at cksdbulldogs.com. Forms are to be returned to the tax collector. Proof must be presented to the tax collector for verification.
4. Tax Collectors will screen each form to verify all required information is completed.
5. The following categories and criteria will be considered for exoneration of the Per Capita taxes:
 - a. A resident taxpayer who has reached 65 years of age, or older, as of July 1 of the taxing year.
 - b. Total household income from all sources shall not exceed \$12,000.
